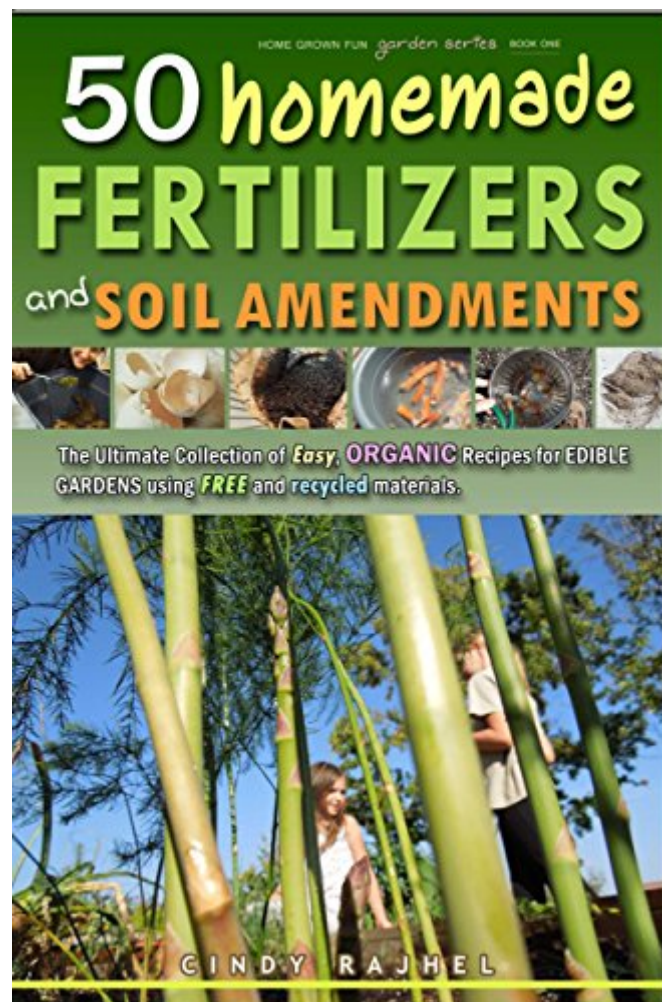

For example, to mimic dolomitic lime, combine Epsom salt with eggshells. Dolomitic lime contains 4 percent calcium carbonate and 38 percent magnesium carbonate. Also use fish trimmings and leftovers from your meals. Any part of the fish works great, including bones and skin. References listed and linked in the back of the book take you to studies that support the information. Do you know which type of manure works best for pumpkins? For tomatoes?
