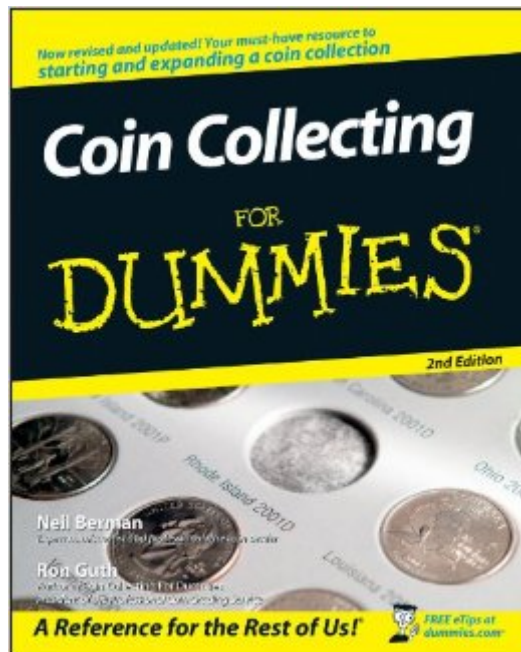

I'd bought a few mint sets, and occasionally thought about saving particularly good-looking coins.

Someone gave me some more coins for Christmas, and I've exploded into coin collecting. There's a ton of stuff to learn. This book covers a lot of it in a very approachable way, and isn't quite as condescending as most of the "For Dummies" books. The humour is a little too frequent for the level of the content, but the book is a great start for the new collector. There's a few sections the book could have done without, like the chapter on record-setting auctions. It would've been great to balance it with a section on the most underrated coins, or the best bargains. If you're interested in getting started, this book is for you. For anyone with experience, it's probably not appropriate.

For any of you who are interested in coin collecting, or if you happen to inherit somehow a collection of coins, this is the book for you! It is filled with information on how to take care of your coins, what to look for when purchasing, selling, trading or anything else regarding coins. The book is full of knowledge that is easy to comprehend. Buy it for yourself or for your kids!
